October Deadlines

• The Bennett Prize 2025 (Open to Women Figurative Realist Painters residing in the US.)

Deadline is October 2, 2024

Entry Fee: \$40

The Bennett Prize is open only to women eighteen (18) years or older residing at least part time in the United States (50 States and Washington, D.C.) whose primary practice is the creation of original paintings in the genre of figurative realism, and who identifies as a woman, regardless of their assigned gender at birth. Watercolor, gouache, and pastels are considered "paint."

The Bennett Prize, administered by The Pittsburgh Foundation, is awarded biennially and provides \$25,000 annually over two consecutive years to the winning artist (\$50,000 total). Ten (10) finalists will be selected to participate in a traveling exhibition organized by the Muskegon Museum of Art (MMA) and the winner will be showcased in a solo exhibition at the close of her grant. A runner up award of \$10,000 will be given to one additional finalist.

The Pittsburgh Foundation and MMA will publish a full-color catalogue in conjunction with the exhibition featuring the artwork of the ten (10) finalists. https://thebennettprize.org/bennett/complete-rules
